## BRETT DEFREITAS TURKEY HEAD PAINTING 270 658 3268

- 1. Clean head with soft brush and air
- 2. Mix brown grey and white together and spray all depth on the head
- 3. Go over the whole head with a medium steel wool
- 4. Apply white to crown and also to wattles
- 5. Apply red to all areas you want red. I usually put it on the face and crown also don't cover every ridge with red it will make your head look more realistic
- 6. Apply a gloss top coat to all red in previous step
- 7. Apply a powder blue or baby blue to all the depth over the area you painted in step 2 then also on the face and crown
- 8. Apply sailfish blue to face and also in the depths closest to the neck(not on top between the ridges) carry this color from face onto and across the snood
- 9. Apply white very carefully to crown and fade onto face to get the color you like. Also lightly mist any red you want to lighten up. Some of the ridges and wattles may also need a little white to soften them up.
- 10. Spray the face and sides of the head with krylon gloss coat to blend the colors
- 11. Spray the same areas in step 10 with a gloss flattener to achieve the best desired amount of shine.
